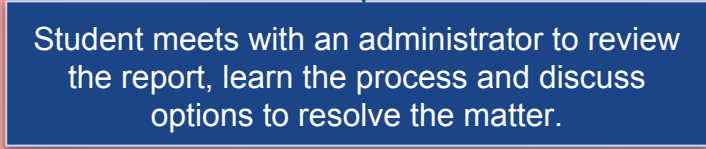


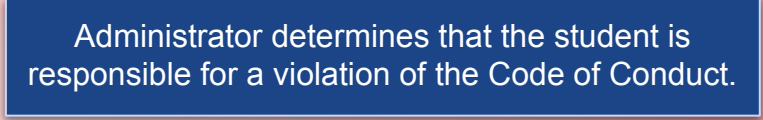
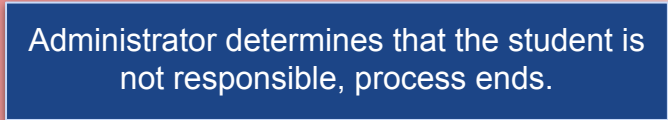


Incidents are assigned to appropriate hearing based on residence, severity or conduct history.

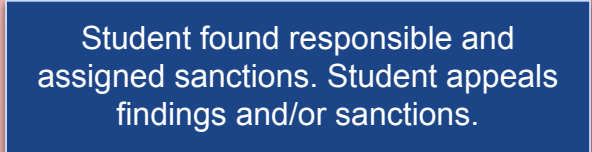
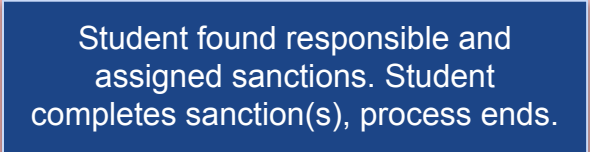


**PREPONDERANCE OF THE EVIDENCE**  
 The standard used to determine whether or not a student is responsible for a policy violation. This means that according to the administrator the reported actions more likely occurred than not.

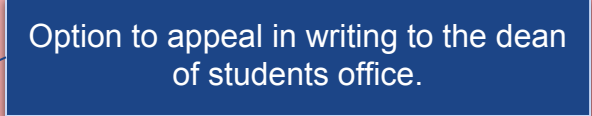
A determination is based on preponderance of the evidence.



**ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING**  
 The student will meet with an administrator to discuss the alleged violation, the student's role, responsibility and the options to resolve the matter. The student will also be advised of the range of possible sanctions.



**SANCTIONS**  
 These are specific requirements or a status assigned to a student who has been found responsible for a violation.



Student can appeal findings based on procedural error in the process or the sanction is disproportionate to the violation.
